3. Business Meeting

John Kies: CIC rep reported on a memory care wanting to add more beds to their facility. They came to CIC for initial approval. Molalla avenue streetscape work is starting soon for improvements between Beavercreek and 213. The Fernway apartments are looking for a variance on signs hoping to add signage to streets to help emergency vehicles find addresses quicker. Downtown Oregon City association had an update at CIC meeting.

Daryl reported that the Police department has a new liaison for homeless; officer Dan Hanes, who took office in December. New police department building is proceeding but completion is getting pushed back.

Officer Mike Paschall reported on the homelessness and graffiti situations.
