**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE NOMINATION OF THE OREGON CITY MCLOUGHLIN BOULEVARD MULTI-MODAL AND TRANSIT IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FOR THE 2028-2030 REGIONAL FLEXIBLE FUND ALLOCATION PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, Metro is soliciting projects for the 2028-2023 Regional Flexible Fund Allocation – Step 1A.1 New Project Bond Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the program is a competitive program with a focus on transit and first/last mile safe access to transit; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the program is to utilize regional revenues on regional or corridor scale projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the program is to advance the ability to construct projects earlier that will otherwise be allocated to other metropolitan areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the program is to continue the past practice to use bonded RFFA revenues to advance transportation projects that improve equitable access to jobs and services, reduce climate impacts, and improve safe travel on the transportation system; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to participate in the program and will commit to provide the indicated dollar match should this project be awarded the requested grant funds; and

**WHEREAS**, Public Works supports the City's application for the 2028-2023 Regional Flexible Fund Allocation – Step 1A.a New Project Bond Program for the Oregon City McLoughlin Boulevard Multi-Modal and Transit Improvements Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Staff is authorized to submit to Metro an application for the 2028-2023 Regional Flexible Fund Allocation – Step 1A.a New Project Bond Program for the Oregon City McLoughlin Boulevard Multi-Modal and Transit Improvements Project.

**Section 2.** This resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
