

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1586

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1386 PROVIDING FOR JURY TRIALS FOR CITY CRIMES AND OFFENSES.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1386 was adopted in 1978 and provided for jury trials for City crimes and offenses, and

WHEREAS, Oregon law does not require a jury trial for non-jailable offenses, and

WHEREAS, since 1981 no City ordinance requires incarceration as a penalty, now, therefore;


THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Read the first time on FEBRUARY 4, 1986, and moved to second reading by UNANIMOUS vote of the City Council.


Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on FEBRUARY 4, 1986.


