ORDINANCE NUMBER 1551

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, PROVIDING REGULATIONS FOR PLUMBING AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM WORK AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1189.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. All repairs, alterations, renovations or installations of plumbing in buildings and structures within the City of Milwaukie, or sewage disposal system repairs, alterations, renovations or installations in and for any building or structure within the city, shall conform to the requirements of the Clackamas County Plumbing Code.
- Section 2. No plumbing or sewage disposal system repair, alteration, renovation or installation regulated by this ordinance shall begin until all permits required have been presented to and validated by the City Public Works Department, and no permit under this ordinance shall be validated in any case where a building permit is also required under the ordinances of the City of Milwaukie unless such building permit shall have been first obtained.
- Section 3. The City Manager is designated as the official responsible for the enforcement of this ordinance and is hereby authorized to contract with the Clackamas County Health Department for the inspection and administration of regulations required by the Clackamas County Plumbing Code and this ordinance.
- Section 4. The provisions of this ordinance shall apply only to plumbing and sewage disposal systems installed in any building or structure to a point not more than five feet outside the line of such building or structure.
- Section 5. Violation of this ordinance shall be punished, upon conviction, by a fine of not more than \$300. Failure to comply with any section of this ordinance or order enforcing regulations hereunder shall be deemed a violation and the penalty provided herein may be imposed for each such violation.
- Section 6. If any part of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall not be affected thereby.
- Section 7. Ordinance Number 1189, passed the 27th day of January, 1969, is repealed.
