

ORDINANCE NO. 1541

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1537 PROHIBITING THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR ADULT BUSINESSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 1537 prohibiting the issuance of permits for adult businesses for 60 days to allow for the development of reasonable regulations for these businesses and,

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that these regulations can't be adopted within the 60 day period due to notice requirements of the Land Conservation and Development Commission, therefore

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1537 is amended by extending the 60 day period to 120 days.

Section 2. Because this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, safety and best interests of the inhabitants of the city, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and signing by the Mayor.

Read the first time on May 17, 1983 and moved to second reading by majority vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on May 19, 1983.

Signed by the Mayor on May 20, 1983.




