

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1488

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE PROVIDING FOR EXPIRATION OF TERMS OF OFFICE FOR CITY COMMISSIONS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1483.

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that terms of office for all appointed offices should expire at the end of February and June 30 of each year and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to extend the terms of incumbent officers to make this change,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. From the effective date of this ordinance, the terms of office for the Civil Service Commission shall expire at the end of February and the new terms shall begin on March 1.

Section 2. From the effective date of this ordinance, the terms of office for the Traffic Safety, Park and Recreation and Senior Citizen Advisory Commissions shall expire on June 30 and the new terms shall begin on July 1.

Section 3. Incumbent members of these commissions shall continue in office until the new expiration date immediately following the date their original term would have expired.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 1483 is repealed.

Read the first time on March 17, 1981, and moved to second reading by majority vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on April 7 1981.
