ORDINANCE NUMBER 1483

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE PROVIDING FOR EXPIRATION OF TERMS OF OFFICE FOR MEMBERS OF CITY COMMISSIONS.

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that terms of office for all appointed offices should expire on February 28 and June 30 of each year and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to extend the terms of incumbent officers to make this change,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. From the effective date of this ordinance, the terms of office for the Budget, Planning and Civil Service Commissions shall expire at the end of February and the new terms shall begin on March 1. Incumbent members of these Commissions shall continue in office until the end of February of the calendar year following the year their original term would have expired.

Section 2. From the effective date of this ordinance, the terms of office for the Traffic Safety, Park and Recreation and Senior Citizen Advisory Commissions shall expire on June 30 and the new terms shall begin on July 1. Incumbent members of these Commissions shall continue in office until June 30 of the calendar year following the year their original term would have expired.

Read the first time on February 17 , 1981 and moved to second reading by unanimous vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on March 3 , 1981.
