

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1476

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1284 (TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION).

WHEREAS, the City desires to have a high school student serve as a voting member of the Traffic Safety Commission, now therefore,

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1284 is amended to read as follows:

The Commission shall consist of seven members appointed by the Mayor with the consent of the Council, with two members recommended by the North Clackamas School District, one of whom must be a student of the Milwaukie High School. Not more than three members may be non-residents. Members shall hold office for two-year terms and may not serve more than two consecutive terms, provided that the City Council may waive this limitation if it is in the best interest of the City to do so. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor with the consent of the Council for the unexpired portion of the term. Members may be removed by the Council for cause.


Read the first time on October 21, 1980, and moved to second reading by unanimous vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on October 21, 1980.
