As provided in the City of Milwaukie Municipal Code Chapter 10.08 Section 020, and having based my determination only upon:

- a. Traffic engineering principles and traffic investigations;
- b. Standards, limitation and rules promulgated by the State Highway Commission;
- c. Other recognized traffic control standards;
- d. Required needs.

### **General Description of Regulation:**

Making the dead end of SE 23<sup>rd</sup> Ave a fire lane.

### **General Location:**

At the dead end of SE 23<sup>rd</sup> Ave north of SE Llewellyn St.

### **Need for Traffic Regulation:**

SE 23<sup>rd</sup> Ave is a narrow road. It cannot accommodate street parking on both sides of the street and still provide sufficient maneuvering room for emergency vehicles.

### **Description for New Traffic Control Measure(s):**

Paint northern curb of SE 23<sup>rd</sup> St and parts of the southern curb red. Add Fire Lane No Parking in white letters to the red curb. Add fire lane signs.

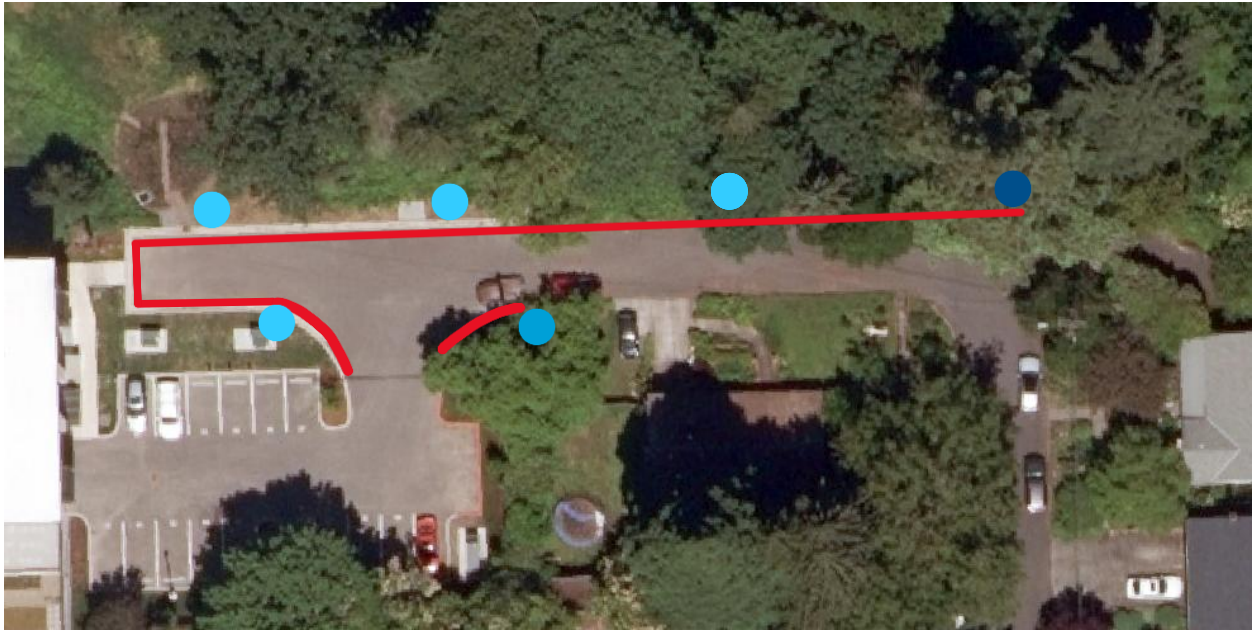
