ORDINANCE NUMBER 1471

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY AND CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF CLACKAMAS COUNTY THE QUESTION OF WHETHER A NEW CITY SHOULD BE CONSOLIDATED AND A CHARTER ADOPTED PURSUANT TO ORS CHAPTER 222.

WHEREAS, the City has received a petition regarding consolidation of the City of Milwaukie with certain unincorporated areas, and

WHEREAS, the boundary for the proposed city was established by order of the Portland Metropolitan Local Government Boundary Commission dated July 16, 1980 and

WHEREAS, a Charter Commission created under authority of ORS 222.240 has prepared and filed with the Council certified copies of a charter for the proposed City of New Milwaukie,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The question of whether a new city to be known as New Milwaukie shall be incorporated and a charter adopted as proposed by the Charter Commission shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City and the unincorporated areas proposed to be included in the new city at the general election on November 4, 1980.

Section 2. The question will be voted on as follows:

PROPOSITION NO. 53. CONSOLIDATION OF MILWAUKIE WITH CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED AREAS.

QUESTION: Shall a city be created by consolidation of Milwaukie and certain unincorporated areas and the proposed charter adopted?

PURPOSE: To incorporate a new city to be known as New Milwaukie by consolidation of the existing incorporated City of Milwaukie with certain adjacent unincorporated areas, under a charter prepared by the Charter Commission. The boundary for the new city will be as established by order of the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission dated July 16, 1980.

Section 3. The City Recorder is directed to give notice of this election in the time and manner required by the Amended Charter of the City and state law.

Read the first time on September 2, 1980, and moved to second reading by unanimous vote of the City Council. $\dot{}$

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on September 2, 1980.
