

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1462

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1433 ADOPTING THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE, 1976 EDITION.

WHEREAS, the City adopted the Uniform Fire Code, 1976 Edition in September, 1979, and provided that the Code would not apply to dwelling units, and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to provide for the enforcement of the Code on vacant buildings to eliminate the fire hazards associated with those structures,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 10 of Ordinance No. 1433 is amended to read as follows:

Section 10. Section 1.103 of the Uniform Fire Code is amended by adding new subparagraph (d) to read:

(d) The provisions of this Code shall not apply to dwelling units unless they have been unoccupied for a period of six months.


Read the first time this 19th day of May, 1980, and moved to second reading by majority vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council this 2nd day of June, 1980.


