ORDINANCE NUMBER 1458

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 520 RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF CARDROOMS.

WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 520 provides for the licensing, taxing and regulation of cardrooms, and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance defines "cardroom" as a place where games of chance are played where a charge is made therefore, and

WHEREAS, the definition above is in conflict with ORS 167.117, which prohibits card games resulting in "house" income, and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined it is in the best interest of the city to allow social games of this kind to be regulated by state law, now, therefore,

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Ordinance Number 520, as amended, is repealed.

Read the first time on <u>April 7</u>, 1980, and moved to second reading by <u>unamious</u> vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on April 7 , 1980.
