ORDINANCE NO. 1969

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON REPEALING MILWAUKIE MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.48—FIRE MARSHAL.

WHEREAS, in 1983 the Milwaukie City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1739, which created the Office of the City Fire Marshal; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1789 was codified as Milwaukie Municipal Code Chapter 2.48—Fire Marshal; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2005 all territory in the City was annexed into Clackamas County Fire District No. 1 (District); and

WHEREAS, upon annexation the District assumed responsibility for all fire protection and suppression services and employs a Fire Marshal and deputies in discharging those responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the City no longer maintains an Office of the City Fire Marshal.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Milwaukie Municipal Code Chapter 2.48—Fire Marshal is repealed.

Read for the first time on March 6, 2007 and moved to a second reading by $\underline{4-0}$ vote of the City Council.

Read the second time and adopted by the City Council on March 6, 2007.
