

**COUNCIL RESOLUTION No. 14-2026**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ACTING AS THE LOCAL CONTRACT REVIEW BOARD, REINSTATING AN ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH AKS ENGINEERING & FORESTRY, LLC, (AKS) FOR THE MEEK STREET STORMWATER PIPELINE PROJECT.**

WHEREAS the city entered a contract with AKS for personal services to complete design and administer construction support on the Meek Street Stormwater Pipeline project; and

WHEREAS the construction of the project has been completed but staff still need to complete the as-built drawings to close out the project; and

WHEREAS staff determined that services were still necessary to complete the as-builts after the contract with AKS expired on December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS staff would like to reinstate this contract through June 30, 2026, to allow AKS sufficient time to complete the remaining scope of services; and

WHEREAS Council has the authority to reinstate contracts under the city's Public Contracting Rules (PCR) 90.025.

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, acting as the Local Contract Review Board, that the engineering services agreement with AKS is reinstated effective upon execution of a contract amendment between the City and AKS. Upon execution of the amendment, the contract will be in full force and effect, as if it had not expired.
