

RESOLUTION NO. 67-2013

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, APPROVING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF 37TH AVENUE AND OAK STREET QUIET ZONE IMPROVEMENTS (CIP-12-004).

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie has identified the desire to improve crossing safety of the Union Pacific Railroad Mainline at 37th Avenue and Oak Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie has identified the project as necessary to the Union Pacific Mainline Quiet Zone project; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation Rail Division has issued Crossing Orders for the quiet zone improvements at the 37th Avenue and Oak Street rail crossings; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Railroad Administration approved the Quiet Zone; and

WHEREAS, the City adopted Resolution No. 61-2007 on October 16, 2007, establishing intent to effectuate a Quiet Zone for the Union Pacific Mainline; and


WHEREAS, the quiet zone improvements were approved for funding in the 2012-2013 budget and 2013-2017 Capital Improvement Plan; and

WHEREAS, Brown Contracting Inc. is the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Milwaukie authorizes the City Manager to sign a contract for the construction of 37th Avenue and Oak Street Quiet Zone Improvements with Brown Contracting Inc. in the amount of \$157,057.20.
