At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners on the date s(above at which time were present Commissioners F. E. Knight and R. F. Brennan, the following business was transacted.




Order was signed in the matter of the transfer within the Budget of \$67,000 from the Road Fund-Bridges and Culverts to the Tillamook County Disaster Fund.

The meeting was opened at 10:00 a.m. by the Chairman.

Order was signed in the matter of the transfer of \$2085 from the Contingency Fund to Sheriff's Radio Maintenance.

Request by the Surveyor to purchase a new chain saw was approved.

Mr. William Clark of Brighton Beach called on the commissioners to request that either the commissioners or himself approach the Highway Division in the matter of determining who actually has jurisdiction of Highway 101 thru Brighton Beach subdivision.

Mr. Shawn, who owns property along the Miami-Foley Road talked to the commissioners about the improvements being made to the road.

Jim Richards reported that no remonstrances had been filed within legal time on the proposed improvement of Sunset and Circle Drive at Neah-Kah-Nie Mountain.

The meeting was recessed at 11:45 a.m.
