

Wednesday, September 5, 1973

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners on the date set above at which time were present Chairman Chas D. Bailey and Commissioners R. F. Brennan and F. E. Knight, the following business was transacted.

Meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 10:00 a.m.

Kathryn Madsen was appointed Justice of the Peace Pro-tem.

Contract was approved for the purchase of Lots 34, 35, 41, 42, Lock 63, Rockaway Beach by Doris F. McRae.

Deed was executed to Byron and Esther Counts for property in Bay View and Sunnyside Additions to Bay City.

The commissioners considered the request of Mr. Nystrom that the county set corners on property he is purchasing at Oceanlake Park. He intimated that the county had surveyed for Mrs. Barnhart in the area. A check with Mr. Carlich disclosed that Mrs. Barnhardt had paid for her survey. The request of Mr. Nystrom was denied.

Erwin Goeres discussed his claim for a cow and a calf again. The Commissioners agreed to pay \$25 for the calf, which there was indication had been killed by a dog, but declined to pay for the cow.

Robert Riley of Nedonna requested to be allowed to purchase rock from the pit at Fishery Point. He was directed to contact the Roadmaster.

County Clerk discussed the matter of purchasing dog tags with the commissioners and also whether a dog control officer would be appointed. She will purchase 2000 tags for 1974.

Meeting recessed at 12:02, and reconvened at 2:00 p.m. at which time bids were opened for furnishing jail meals. Sheriff submitted the only bid. He submitted a bid of 55¢ per meal, which was accepted.

Paul Howard, CTIC Secretary brought in flood plain maps for the Planning Department.
