1. Letter was read from Clackamas County Housing Authority, dated January 29, 1971, enclosing letter from Department of Housing and Human Development, dated January 22, 1971, re low cost housing projects in Milwaukie.
2. Letter was read from Sara Follen, Chairman of Metro Youth '71, dated January 29, 1971, re SECOND WIND, a youth-sponsored food drive in February, 1971. It was moved by Hupp, seconded by Stochosky, that the request for waiver of the fees be denied. After discussion, it was moved by Fuller, seconded by Stochosky, that

the motion be tabled. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Hupp, seconded by Fuller, that the bills listed for February 9, 1971 payment be approved for payment. Motion carried and so ordered.
