

Wednesday, August 7, 1974




Mr. Knight moved that Tillamook County approve the Nortec Solid Waste Report for Tillamook County. Seconded by Mr. Brennan and carried.

Lorne Smith, Youth Progress Association, requested permission for his boys to improve a Park Area up the Wilson River and requested that county furnish some material needed for repairs to facilities. Commissioners agreed, However, exact location will have to be determined, as to whether county or state has jurisdiction.

Planning Director Dan Cowee and Subdivision Coordinator Jim Richards, together with Leuthold of Foley Creek Development discussed approval of an addition to be platted thereto.
