It was moved by Stochosky, seconded by Fuller, that the Consent Calendar be approved. Motion carried and so ordered.

REQUEST FROM RESIDENTS OF RHODESA RE PETITION FOR L. I. D.

Letter from "Residents of Rhodessa" was read, asking why no action had been taken on their petition for street improvements. Memorandum from Director of Public Works, dated September 27, 1972, was read, explaining the problems. The Director of Public Works asked the Council for a firm policy on procedures when acquisition of right-of-way is necessary for street improvements. A meeting will be held with the property owners on Rhodessa at 7:30 p. m. Thursday, October 12, 1972, in the City Manager's office.

LETTER FROM STATE HIGHWAY DIVISION RE STATE RECREATION PLANNING

The Council has received a letter from Oregon State Highway Division, dated September 18, 1972, announcing public forums on development of a comprehensive state park and recreation system, and asking questions on the subject. The letter was referred to the Parks and Beautification Committee for suggested answers, to be presented at the next Council meeting.

CORRESPONDENCE

1. Letter was read from Paul Meermeier, 4216 S. E. Mason Lane, asking why work had not yet commenced on the Mason Lane L. I. D. It was requested that Mr. Meermeier be contacted and given an explanation of the problem.

REQUEST BY NORRIS & STEVENS TO REPLACE SIGN IN STREET R. O. W.

Request has been received from Norris & Stevens, Realtors, dated September 7, 1972, for approval of replacing existing sign in street right-of-way at the intersection of River Road and Lava Drive. It was moved by Stochosky, seconded by Fuller, to deny the request for change in the size of the sign. Motion carried and so ordered. Mayor Graf requested his vote be recorded as "No."

A RESOLUTION SETTING MAXIMUM SALARIES FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON.

It was moved by Stochosky, seconded by Hupp, that the Council table discussion of a resolution setting maximum salaries for employees of the city of Milwaukie, until it has been discussed at a work session with regard to its long-range implications and long-range effects on the people involved, and on city bargaining agreements. Motion carried and so ordered.

AGREEMENT RE LIBRARY FOUNTAIN

The artist who is constructing the Peake Memorial Fountain in the Library grounds has requested an agreement giving him first right to purchase the fountain if the city or the Peakes ever decide to dispose of it. The City Manager was directed to write a letter to the Peakes asking their opinion of this procedure.

MEMORANDUM FROM CITY MANAGER RE SIDEWALK REPAIR

Memorandum was read from the City Manager, dated October 2, 1972, requesting the Council, under Ordinance 1221, to direct the Manager to post "Notice of Sidewalk Repair" on Main Street between Jackson and Monroe Streets. It was moved by Fuller, seconded by Stochosky, that the City Manager be directed to post such notice immediately. Motion carried and so ordered.

OTHER BUSINESS


1. It was moved by Hupp, seconded by Fuller, that the City Manager write a letter to the State Highway Department requesting them to clean out the storm drain at McLoughlin and Washington. Motion carried and so ordered.
2. Memo was read to Councilman Bill Hupp, through Mayor and City Council, from the City Manager, dated October 2, 1972, answering questions regarding transfer of funds by Resolution 18-1972.
3. Letter was read from Bill E. Hupp to the Board of County Commissioners, Mr. Schumacher, Mr. Telford and Mr. Stefani, dated July 20, 1972.

PAYMENT OF BILLS


It was moved by Stochosky, seconded by Fuller, that the bills listed for October 3, 1972 payment be approved for payment. Motion carried and so ordered.
