1090th Meeting

The one thousand ninetieth meeting of the Council of the city of Milwaukie, Oregon, was held on the 28th day of October, 1968. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Robert E. Richmond with the following councilmen present:

It was moved by Slominski, seconded by Strauss, that the minutes of the regular meeting of October 14, 1968 be approved as written. Motion carried and so ordered. It was moved by Graf, seconded by Slominski, that the minutes of the special meeting of October 24, 1968 be approved as written. Motion carried and so ordered.

PATH BETWEEN 47TH STREET AND WINWORTH COURT

Mrs. Robert Anderson, 4705 S. E. Arden, read a letter to the Council from the Seth Llewelling PTA, asking for action by the city to block the above path to motor vehicles, and put it in a safe and usable condition. It was moved by Graf, seconded by Slominski, that the city engineer be instructed to block off one end of the 20-foot right-of-way, and that the city attorney look into the legal aspects of the possibility of blocking both ends, and report back to the Council at the next meeting; that the city engineer present an estimate of the cost to gravel the right-of-way at the next meeting. Motion carried and so ordered.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 62-1968, ACCEPTING BID FOR WATER BONDS

It was moved by Clore, seconded by Slominski, that Resolution Number 62-1968 (A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BID FOR PURCHASE OF \$900,000.00 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND RECONSTRUCTION OF THE WATER SERVICE SYSTEM AND WORKS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON) be read and adopted. Motion carried and so ordered.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1184, CREATING AND ESTABLISHING FIRE ZONES

It was moved by Slominski, seconded by Clore, that Ordinance Number 1184, (AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING FIRE ZONES; REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1001 AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY) be read the first time. Motion carried and so ordered. It was moved by Clore, seconded by Strauss, that Section 6 of Ordinance Number 1184 be amended to

read as follows: "...an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect upon the effective date of the zoning ordinance for the city of Milwaukie, November 14, 1968." Motion carried and so ordered. It was moved by Strauss, seconded by Slominski, that Ordinance Number 1184 be read the second time by title only. Motion carried unanimously and so ordered. After reading, Ordinance Number 1184 was put on its passage with the following roll call vote: AYES: Strauss, Slominski, Graf, Clore and Richmond. NOES: None. Ordinance Number 1184 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.

PUC APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT RAIL CROSSING

It was moved by Clore, seconded by Graf, that the City Council authorize the mayor to execute the petition to the PUC for authority to construct rail crossing at Harrison Street, have his signature attested by the recorder and notarized, and forward the petition to the PUC office. Motion carried and so ordered.

Motion carried and so ordered. Commissioner Clore asked that the record show that he did not vote on this motion because of a possible conflict of interest.

APPLICATION FOR ZONE CHANGE - Tony Borne

Attorney R. Dale Kneeland, 0305 S. W. Curry, Portland, representing Mr. Borne, addressed the council asking a zone change at 3916 Harrison. It was moved by Graf, seconded by Strauss, that the council accept the recommendation of the Planning Commission, and deny zone change application ZC-68-9. Motion carried and so ordered.

REQUEST FOR EASEMENT - Louis Gold

Attorney Charles L. Kobin, 314 Oregon Bank Building, Portland, representing Mr. Gold, addressed the council requesting an easement across city property at the North end of 23rd Street. It was moved by Graf, seconded by Slominski, that the council accept the recommendation of the Planning Commission and deny the request for easement. Motion carried and so ordered.

GARBAGE COLLECTION RATE CHANGE

It was moved by Strauss, seconded by Slominski, that the contract for rates for refuse collection be amended to increase residential rates, effective December 1, 1968, for one stop per week, one can, to \$2 per month, and for one stop per week, two cans, to \$3.50 per month. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was announced there would be a special meeting of the City Council Friday, November 8, 1968 at 6 p. m. , for the express purpose of canvassing the vote of the general election on November 5, 1968.

It was announced the regular meeting of the Council on November 11, 1968 would be cancelled because it falls on a holiday.


RESOLUTION NUMBER 61-1968, OAK STREET AND HARRISON STREET SIGNALS

It was moved by Clore, seconded by Graf, that Resolution Number 61-1968 (A RESOLUTION APPROVING, ACCEPTING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AGREEMENTS PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF AUTOMATIC SIGNALLING DEVICES AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILROAD AT OAK STREET AND HARRISON STREET, WITHIN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON) be read as amended to correct the description of the location of the signals. Motion carried and so ordered. After reading it was moved by Graf, seconded by Clore, that Resolution Number 61-1968 be adopted as amended. Motion carried and so ordered.


PAYMENT OF BILLS
