The meeting was called to order by Mayor Joseph Bernard, Jr.



After discussion, it was moved by Richmond and seconded by Renard that a concrete bridge be constructed over Johnson Creek at Milport Road. Motion carried and so ordered.

An application for recommendation of a Class "A" Dispensers License for Chalet L'Abbe at 2311 6th Street, was laid before the Council by Jewel B. Abei. It was moved by Renard and seconded by Richmond that the Council recommend that license as requested. Motion carried and so ordered.
