

SPECIAL MEETING OF JULY 10, 1963

A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, was held on the tenth day of July, 1963, for the purpose of reading Ordinance No. 983 for its second reading.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Joseph M. Bernard Jr. at 12:30 P.M.

Those present were Mayor Joseph M. Bernard Jr.; Councilmen Charles Renard and Walter Freeman; City Manager Leonard B. Mullan, Assistant City Manager Max Thompson and Clerk Ellen Martin. Those absent were Councilmen Theron Sedgwick and Robert Richmond and Attorney John O. Sheldahl.

It was moved by Councilman Renard that Ordinance Number 983 be taken up and read at this time and that it be read by title only for this reading. Councilman Freeman seconded the motion. On being put to a vote the motion carried and was so ordered.

Ordinance Number 983 AN ORDINANCE adopting the 1963-1964 budget for the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, providing a tax levy on all taxable property within the said City for City purposes beginning July 1, 1963, and ending June 30, 1964, and declaring an emergency, was taken up and read by title only for its second reading and put on its passage with the following result being had: Ayes: Renard, Freeman and Bernard. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 983 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
