

SPECIAL MEETING OF JANUARY 24, 1962

A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held on the twenty-fourth day of January, 1962, for the purpose of opening the bids for the expansion by secondary treatment for the Sewage Disposal Plant and such other business necessary to come before the Council at this time.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Earl Clay.

The roll call showed the following present: Mayor Earl M. Clay; Councilman James Howard, Charles Renard, E. H. Aebi and Theron Sedgwick; City Manager Leonard Mullan and City Attorney John O. Sheldahl. Absent: Ellen Martin, Clerk. Also present were Engineers Marvin Runyan and Carl Reinke of Stevens & Thompson, Consultant Engineers.

There was discussion on the matter of placing a third fire station in the eastern section of the City. It was moved by Councilman Aebi and seconded by Councilman Howard that Manager Mullan make a survey of property at Linwood Avenue for location. for a fire station. Motion carried and so ordered.
