

SPECIAL MEETING OF AUGUST 6, 1962

A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held on the sixth day of August, for the purpose of a hearing on the question of sewers along 47th Street and along Logus Road from 47th Street to a point approximately 700 feet east of Winworth Road and such other business necessary to come before the Council at this time.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Clay.

Present: Mayor Earl Clay: Councilmen James Howard, Charles Renard,

Theron Sedgwick; Manager Mullan, Attorney John O. Sheldahl and Clerk Ellen Martin. Absent : Councilman Paul Baer.

The Mayor opened the hearing on the question of sewers along 47th Street in Leone Acres, and along Logus Road from 47th Street to a point approximately 700 feet east of Winworth Road, and called for objection to the same. There were several property owners present who made inquiry as to how assessments would be made. There was no person present who objected to the sewers being installed and no written objection had been received. The Mayor declared the hearing closed.

Ordinance Number 927 was taken up and read for its first reading. It was moved by Howard and seconded by Sedgwick that Ordinance Number 927 be moved to its second reading.

The Mayor announced that there would be a Special meeting of the Council at the hour of twelve o'clock on the morrow, for the second reading of Ordinance Number 927.
