

SPECIAL MEETING OF AUGUST 7, 1962

A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held on the seventh day of August, 1962, for the purpose of the second reading of Ordinance Number 927.

The meeting was called to order at noon, by Mayor Earl Clay.

Ordinance Number 927 AN ORDINANCE providing for the construction of sanitary sewers along 47th Street ~~and~~ along Logus Road from 47th Street easterly a distance of approximately 700 feet east of Winworth Road, and to construct laterals from the sanitary sewers to the property lines where the same are requested, directing the City Manager to give notice inviting proposals therefor by publishing notice in the Daily Journal of Commerce, and declaring an emergency, was taken up and read for its second reading and put on its passage with the following result being had.
