

SPECIAL MEETING OF JUNE 3, 1960

The Council of the City of Milwaukie met in special session for the purpose of a hearing on the annexation of territories as described in Ordinance Number 796, and for the purpose of canvassing the votes of elections held on this date.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Clay.

Present: Mayor Clay; Councilmen Howard, Mortensen and Aebi. Manager Mullan and Clerk Martin. Absent: Councilman Sedgwick and Attorney Sheldahl.

At the hour of 8:30 o'clock P.M. the Mayor opened the hearing on the annexation of territories as described in Ordinance Number 796. It was shown that proper notice had been published and posted. There was no citizen present who protested the annexation. At the hour of nine o'clock P.M. the Mayor declared the hearing closed.

On account of the lateness of the hour and word from the election precincts indicated that the Election Boards would not be able to return a statement of election for some time, the Mayor declared that the Council would meet at 12:30 P.M. on the morrow, Saturday, June 4, 1960, to canvass the votes of elections.
