

SPECIAL MEETING OF JUNE 6, 1960

A special meeting was held, at the call of the Mayor, on the sixth day of June, 1960, for the purpose of reviewing the 1960-61 City Budget and setting a date for a hearing on the same, and such other business necessary to come before the Council at this time.

The meeting was called to order at eight o'clock P.M. by Mayor Earl Clay.


Those present were Mayor Clay; Councilman James Howard, Ernest Aebi and Theron Sedgwick; City Manager Leonard Mullan and Attorney John Sheldahl.  
Absent: Councilman Peter Mortensen and Clerk Ellen Martin.

The Council made survey of the City Budget for the fiscal year of 1960-1961.

It was moved by Aebi and seconded by Sedgwick that the date for public hearing on the City Budget be set for June 29, 1960 at the hour of eight o'clock P.M. Motion carried and so ordered.

Manager Mullan read a report from Jossy, Witt, Englund, Contractors, on the progress of the new Fire Station at 40th and Harvey Streets. The letter stated that the amount now owing Mason and Brenner, Contractors, was \$9,793.80. It was moved by Councilman Howard and seconded by Councilman Aebi that Mason and Brenner Contractors, be paid \$9,793.80, for work done to date on the Fire Station at 40th and Harvey Streets. Motion carried and so ordered.
