A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held at the call of the Mayor on the twenty-eighth day of August, 1961, for the purpose of receiving petitions for annexation and acting on the same.

SPECIAL MEETING

AUGUST 28, 1961

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Clay.

Present: Mayor Earl M. Clay; Councilmen James Howard, Charles Renard, E. H. Aebi and Theron Sedgwick; City Manager Leonard Mullan and City Attorney John O. Sheldahl. Absent: Ellen Martin, Clerk.

Mr. Floyd Bennett and Dr. George Corti laid before the Council petitions and consents of annexations which were signed by the owners of properties lying east of the east city limit line, south of Minthorn Addition, west of John D. Garrett D.L.C. and Vernie Road and north of Kellogg Creek. The petitions had been signed by 78.46 per cent of the owners of the property and represented 76.85 percent of the acreage and 83.41 per cent of the assessed value of the land. The Council was requested to act upon these petitions as soon as possible. Attorney Sheldahl advised the Council of the provisions of Chapter 511, Oregon Laws 1961.

Ordinance Number 850 was taken up and read for its first reading. It was moved by Councilman Howard and seconded by Councilman Aebi that Ordinance Number 850 be passed to its second reading and that it be read at this time. Motion carried and so ordered.

Ordinance Number 850, AN ORDINANCE providing for the procedure, without election, to annex certain territory contiguous to the present boundaries of the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 511, Oregon Laws 1961; accepting written consents of landowners in such territory to said annexation; determining that at least two-thirds of said consenting landowners also own at least two-thirds of the land in the said contiguous territory and own real property therein representing at least two-thirds of the assessed value of the real property in the said contiguous territory; fixing a day for a public hearing before the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the question of such annexation; directing publication and posting of notice of such hearing; and declaring an emergency.

Ordinance Number 850 was again taken up and read for its second reading and put on its passage with the following result being had, Ayes: James Howard, Charles Renard, E. H. Aebi, Theron Sedgwick and Earl Clay. Ordinance Number 850 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
