

MEETING OF JUNE 10, 1957

COUNCIL CHAMBER

911th MEETING

The nine hundred eleventh regular meeting of the Council of the City of Milwaukie was held on the tenth day of June, 1957.

In the absence of Mayor Mullan, the meeting was called to order by Councilman Roberts.

Present: Councilmen Roberts, Clay, Mortensen and Klein; Manager Burdick, Attorney Sheldahl and Clerk Martin. Absent: Mayor Mullan.

The minutes of the nine hundred tenth regular meeting of the Council, held on the thirteenth day of May, 1957, were approved as written.

The minutes of a special meeting of the Council, held on the twentieth day of May, 1957, were approved as written.

The minutes of a special meeting of the Council, held on the twenty-seventh day of May, 1957, were approved as written.

Manager Burdick reported that adjustments on the assessment of $1\frac{1}{2}$ cents per square foot for the lift station and trunk line in Railroad Avenue, had not been decided upon, and made inquiry about lowering the assessment, for the present, on those properties not yet served by sewers, and assessing the balance to them when sewers, serving them, are installed. The matter was referred to the Attorney.

Dr. W. W. Schafer, 404 - 40th Street, came before the Council and reported that there was a Lot or Tract of land west of the City's reservoir large enough for a baseball diamond for the small boys in the neighborhood of which there are many, and requested that this use be made of the property during the time that it remains vacant land. It was agreed that the matter be referred to the Manager and left to his discretion.

Mr. Wm. Charack, Attorney for the owners of Tax Lot 40, Whitcomb D.L.C. came before the Council with regard to the improvement and extension of Campbell Street, through the property, and requested that the city furnish fill rock for a low place in the same. The Council informed Mr. Charack that, while they would like to help, they did not feel that they could spend funds from the street department budget for this street when it was so desperately needed for other streets.

Mr. Sig Olafson came before the Council and requested that they approve the relocation of the State Liquor Store in Milwaukie. The proposed new location being the old Post Office location at 1925 Monroe Street. It was moved by Mortensen and seconded by Clay that a letter, approving the new location, and signed by the Mayor, be sent to Mr. Olafson. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Roberts and seconded by Clay that the following Resolution be adopted.

RESOLUTION NO. 11-1957

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING JURISDICTION OVER CERTAIN COUNTY ROADS PLACED IN AND GIVEN TO THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, BY ORDER OF THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON AND FOR THE COUNTY OF CLACKAMAS, COURT ORDER NUMBER 5123

WHEREAS, by appropriate statutory procedure, the County Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Clackamas did, by its Court Order Number 5123, place in and give to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, jurisdiction over the following County Roads and portions thereof, to-wit:

A PORTION OF THE N. J. ALLEN ROAD NUMBER 1022, OCHOCO STREET, EAST OF RIVER ROAD AND WEST OF MOORE'S STREET, COUNTY ROAD NUMBER 1979-J, LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF

MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON.

AND WHEREAS the said County did, by its said order, further provide that the City of Milwaukie must accept said jurisdiction within ninety days from the date of the Order,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, and by virtue of the provisions of ORS. 373.270, that the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, does hereby accept the jurisdiction over the County Road hereinabove described, as the said jurisdiction was placed in and given to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, by Court Order Number 5123 of the County Court of the State of Oregon, for the County of Clackamas.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copy of this Resolution be forthwith transmitted to the County Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Clackamas.

Manager Burdick read a letter, from the League of Oregon Cities, inviting the Council to attend their meeting in Oswego on June 20.

Manager Burdick read a letter from the Volunteer Fire Department, inviting the Council to attend their next meeting on June 17.

Manager Burdick read a letter, signed by Harland E. Olson, Deputy Sheriff, relating to an Employees' Credit Union, which would include employees of the State, Counties and Cities. The Council agreed that the matter be referred to the City employees for their consideration and that they report to the Council as to their wishes in the matter.

Manager Burdick read a letter from Portland General Electric Co. in which they stated that they had been requested to place street lighting around the former Administration Building in Milwaukie Industrial Park, the request having been made by the Milwaukie Elks Lodge. There was discussion on the matter during which it was suggested that the Elks have flood lights placed around the building. It was moved by Mortensen and seconded by Clay that the letter be tabled for the present time. Motion carried and so ordered.

Manager Burdick read a letter from Northwest Coal and Ice Co. in which they requested that they be notified of any proposal to vacate any street in Milwaukie Industrial Park which might affect their property.

Attorney Sheldahl was instructed to prepare an easement across the William Davis property for the purpose of a storm drain in Main Street.

Manager Burdick reported that Don Thornton, Contractor, had signed the contract for construction of storm drains in 33rd, 34th, 35th and Washington Streets, today, and that work would begin immediately.

Manager Burdick reported that the Eagles Lodge had requested a recommendation for a license to sell beer at a dance which they contemplate having soon. It was moved by Mortensen and seconded by Clay that the Council recommend that the Eagles Lodge be permitted to sell beer at their dance to be given soon. Motion carried and so ordered.

The Police Chief's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

It was moved by Clay and seconded by Klein that the following bills be approved and that warrants be drawn for the payment of same.
