

SPECIAL MEETING OF JANUARY 31, 1958

A special meeting of the Council of the City of Milwaukie, was held on the thirty-first day of January, 1958, for the purpose of hearing on the Vacation of a portion of Olsen Street in Milwaukie Industrial Park.

## SPECIAL MEETING OF JANUARY 31, 1958

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Mullan.


Present: Mayor Mullan; Councilmen Clay, Mortensen, Roberts and Klein, and Manager Burdick. Absent: Attorney Sheldahl and Clerk Martin.

The notice of the hearing as published and posted, was read. The Mayor called for remonstrances or protests to the vacation of a portion of Olsen Street Milwaukie Industrial Park. There was no citizen present who made objection.

Ordinance Number 702 was taken up and read in full for its first reading. It was moved by Roberts and seconded by Clay that Ordinance Number 702 be passed to its second reading and that it be read at this time. Motion carried and so ordered.

Ordinance Number 702, AN ORDINANCE vacating a portion of Olsen Street heretofore dedicated as such in that part of Milwaukie Industrial Park, Milwaukie, Oregon, lying to the east of U.S. Highway 99E, the plat of which is recorded in Volume 29, Page 12, Record of Town-plats, Clackamas County, Oregon, as Plat Number 803, and declaring an emergency, was taken up and read for its second reading and put on its passage with the following results being had. Ayes: Mullan, Clay, Mortensen, Roberts and Klein. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 702 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.
