

MEETING OF JULY 26, 1954

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

849th MEETING

The eight hundred forty-ninth regular meeting of the Council was held on the twenty-sixth day of July, 1954.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Mullan

Present: Mayor Mullan; Councilmen Shook, Clay, Wright and Klein.

The minutes of the eight hundred forty-eighth regular meeting of the Council, held on the twelfth day of July, 1954, were approved as written.

It was moved by Wright and seconded by Shook that the following bills be allowed:

Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Klein, seconded by Clay that Dan Harmon be given a temporary permit to move a small building on the Lot at the southeast corner of McLoughlin Blvd and Jefferson Streets; said building to be placed not less than 10 feet from all lines of said Lot. Motion carried and so ordered.

Leo Fontana appeared before the Council and requested that he be permitted to construct sidewalk in front of his premises on 31st Street. There was no action taken.

Mr. and Mrs. Fisher appeared before the Council to object to the closing of the South pedestrian lane at the corner of Monroe and McLoughlin Blvd. Matter discussed but no action taken.

At eight o'clock the Mayor called the attention of all present that the hour had arrived for discussion on regard to the annexation of a part of Block 77, Minthorn Addition to the City of Portland, Oregon and a part of Block 4, and a part of Block 5 Keil Heights Number 2. No one appeared either for or against the proposition.

It was moved by Shook, seconded by Wright that the City Attorney prepare an ordinance for the annexation of such property. Motion carried and so ordered.

The City Attorney read the ordinance which he had prepared for such annexation ordinance being Ordinance Number 603.

It was moved by Shook and seconded by Wright that Ordinance No. 603 be passed to its second reading. Motion carried and so ordered.
