

SPECIAL MEETING OF MAY 21, 1956

A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held on the twenty-first day of May, 1956


The meeting, which was called for the purpose of opening bids for the laying of a water main to the Pendleton Woolen Mills property, was called to order by Mayor Mullan.

Present: Mayor Mullan; Councilmen Perkins Clay and Shook, Manager Burdick and Engineer Marvin Runyan. Absent: Councilman Klein, Attorney Sheldahl and Recorder Martin.

A Bid presented by Lord Bros. in the amount of \$15,123.00 was opened at eight (8:00) o'clock P.M.

After analysis of the Engineer's estimates and the Bid price, and the taking into consideration the fine services rendered to the City in the past by Lord Bros. for similar work, and also, they having been the low bidder on previous jobs, the Council decided to award the Bid to Lord Bros. and it was so moved by Clay and seconded by Shook, also that the Mayor be authorized to sign the contract. The motion was unanimously carried by those present.
