

SPECIAL MEETING OF JULY 12, 1955

A special meeting of the Council was held, at the call of the Mayor, on the twelvth day of July, 1955.

The meeting, which was called for the purpose of reading Ordinance Number 619, was called to order by Mayor Mullan.

Present: Mayor Mullen, Councilmen Shook, Klein and Wright; and Recorder Martin. Absent: Councilman Clay.

Ordinance Number 619 AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City of Milwaukie, Oregon to enter into a contract with Pendleton Woolen Mills, an Oregon Corporation, for the purpose of protecting and relocating its easements across a part of the Donation Land Claims of Lot Whitcomb, Nos. 38 and 41, and William Meek, No. 50, in T. 1 S., R 1 E. of the W. M., in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, and declaring an emergency, was taken up and read in full for its second reading and put on its passage with the following results being had: Ayes: Mullan, Shook, Klein, Wright. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 619 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.
