

SPECIAL MEETING OF AUGUST 30, 1957

A special meeting of the Council of Milwaukie was held at the call of the Mayor for the purpose of a public hearing the matter of annexing certain territories into the City of Milwaukie, on the 30th day of August, 1957.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Mullan. Present; Mayor Mullan, Councilmen Mortensen, Roberts and Klein; Attorney Sheldahl and Clerk Martin. Absent: Councilman Clay and Manager Burdick.

It was shown that notices of this public hearing had been posted in public places and that it had been published in the Milwaukie Review.

Mayor Mullan called for objection or remonstrance to the annexation of any of the properties as listed in Ordinance 679. There was no citizen present who objected to annexation of any of the listed territories.

Ordinance Number 680 was taken up and read for its first reading. It was moved by Klein and seconded by Roberts that Ordinance Number 680 be passed to its second reading. Motion carried and so ordered.
