

ADJOURNED MEETING OF NOVEMBER 16, 1949

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

An adjourned meeting of the seven hundred thirty-sixth regular meeting of the Council was held on the sixteenth day of November, 1949.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Sperr.

Present: Mayor Sperr; Councilmen Mortensen and Norbeck; Manager Taber, Attorney Kirkpatrick, and Recorder Martin. Absent: Councilmen Taylor and Prady.

Major Casebeer and Colonel Richards, of the Clackamas County Reserve Officers Corps, came before the Council with regard to using the fire proof room in the basement of the City Hall, for storing their supplies. It was agreed that after the water department supplies, now in the room, were moved to the new storage warehouse under construction at 40th and Harvey, the Reserve Officers Corps could use the fireproof room in the basement for storage of equipment and that if they so desired they could have space in the Council room for a filing cabinet.

Ordinance Number 535 was taken up and read for its first reading. It was moved by Mortensen and seconded by Norbeck that Ordinance Number 535 be passed to its second reading. Motion carried and so ordered.

There being no further business to come before the Council at this time the meeting adjourned.
