

SPECIAL MEETING OF AUGUST 16, 1949

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

There was a special meeting of the Council held on the sixteenth day of August, 1949.

The meeting, which was called to order by Mayor Sperr, was called for the purpose of opening bids for painting the exterior woodwork of the City Hall and for the opening of bids for the repair of the City Hall roof and for such other business as was necessary to be brought before the Council at this time.

Present Mayor Sperr; Councilmen Taylor, Mortensen, and Norbeck; Manager Taber, and Attorney Kirkpatrick. Absent: Councilman Frady.

It was moved by Mortensen and seconded by Taylor that the action taken by the Council at the meeting of July 25, 1949, authorizing the Manager to buy an Armco Steelox Building, be reconsidered. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Sperr and seconded by Norbeck that the motion authorizing the purchase of a Standard Armco Steelox building, passed by the Council at the meeting of July 25, 1949, be rescinded. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Sperr and seconded by Norbeck that the Manager be authorized to purchase a Ray Becker building as per drawing No. E-4171, with one change, namely, that the window in the west end of the machinery room be changed to a 4' X 7' door, and that the price as specified in their letter to the Council be \$6,639.00. The motion carried and was so ordered.

Bids for painting the exterior wood work of the City Hall, (two coats) were opened and read as follows:

H.W. McGowan	\$390.00
J.F. Transue	315.00
Jerry Carpenter	300.60

It was moved by Taylor and seconded by Mortensen that if the bid is in order, the bid of Jerry Carpenter be accepted. Motion carried and so ordered.

Bids for repairing the roof of the City Hall were opened and read as follows:

Panther Oil & Grease Co.	429.90

The bid of the Panther Oil and Grease Co. was irregular in that it called for furnishing materials only and did not include labor.

It was moved by Taylor and seconded by Mortensen that the bids be rejected and that the Manager call for new bids. Motion carried and so ordered.
