SPECIAL MEETING

There was a special meeting of the Council, held at the call of the Mayor, on the twenty-third day of May, 1945.

The meeting, which was called to order by Mayor Sperr, was called for the purpose of discussing and outlining the 1945-46 City Budget and any other business which the Council saw fit to transact at this time.

Present: Mayor Sperr; Councilmen Rowe, Roberts and Hamlin; Auditor Phillips, Attorney Kirkpatrick and Recorder Martin. Absent: Councilman Nelson.

A proposed budget for Milwaukie was prepared and will be presented to the Budget Committee at their meeting on the twenty-eighth day of May, 1945.

It was moved by Roberts and seconded by Hamlin that the City sell their power lawn mower to the Housing Authority of Clackamas County for the purchase price of \$418.75. Motion carried and so ordered.

There being no further business to come before the Council at this time the meeting was adjourned.
