COUNCIL CHAMBERS

SPECIAL MEETING

There was a special meeting of the Council, held at the call of the Mayor, on the first day of August, 1945.

The meeting, which was called for the purpose of making arrangements, and setting the rate of pay for the census of the City, and for such other urgent matters as were necessary to come before the Council at this time, was called to order by Mayor Sperr.

Present: Mayor Sperr, Councilmen Hamlin, Roberts, Nelson and Rowe; Manager Kelsey, Attorney Kirkpatrick, Water Superintendent Counsell and Recorder Martin.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Hamlin that the pay for the enumerators of the census be five (5¢) cents per name for all names, registered by them, which are accepted. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Hamlin and seconded by Rowe that the supervisor of the census be paid two cents each for all named registered by the several enumerators which are accepted. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Hamlin that Manager Kelsey be authorized to make any necessary changes in the arrangements and personnel, including the rates of pay, for the census. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Hamlin and seconded by Sperr that the City purchase five copies of "Uniform Building Code" compiled by Pacific Coast Building Officials Conference, 1943 Edition. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. Hamlin ask if the new building ordinance provided that a permit be required for any alteration to a building.

Mayor Sperr announced that there would be a special meeting of the Council held on the 6th day of August, 1945, for the purpose of taking up Ordinance Number 465, at the hour of 7:30 P. M.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
