

SPECIAL MEETING OF DECEMBER 18, 1944

There was a special meeting of the Council held, at the call of the Mayor, on the eighteenth day of December, 1944.

The meeting, which was called for the purpose of discussion of the election which will be held pursuant to Section 37 of the new charter, was called to order by Mayor Roberts.

Present: Mayor Roberts; Councilmen Bevington, McClure, Sperr and Rowe, and Recorder Martin. Absent: Councilman Newman.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by McClure that an ordinance be prepared and posted providing that the area of Ward Number One of Milwaukie, be enlarged to include Kellogg Park. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by McClure that an ordinance be prepared and posted providing that a special election be held on the ninth day of February, 1945, pursuant to Section 37 of the new Charter. Motion carried and so ordered.

On motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
