

SPECIAL MEETING OF NOVEMBER 7, 1940

A special meeting of the council was held on the 7th day of November, 1940, for the purpose of canvassing the returns of the general election and special election, held on the 5th day of November, 1940, in accordance with the provisions of Section 10 of the City Charter.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Roberts. Present: Mayor Roberts, Councilmen Gillem, Kirkpatrick, Mourer, Rivers and Rudder; Marshal Rigdon and Recorder Adams.

The returns of the general election and the special election, each held on the 5th day of November, 1940, were presented to the Council by the Recorder for the Council's consideration.
