

MEETING OF MAY 10, 1943.

580th MEETING.

The five hundred eightieth regular meeting of the Council was held on the tenth day of May 1943.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Roberts.

Present: Mayor Roberts; Councilmen Newman, Bevington, Sperr and Rowe; Treasurer Farrington, Attorney Adams, Water Superintendent Counsell, and Recorder Martin. Absent: Councilman McClure and Fire Chief Steiner.

The minutes of the five hundred seventy-ninth regular meeting of the Council held on the twenty-sixth day of April 1943, were read and discussed, approval or correction was postponed until the next regular meeting of the Council.

Mr. Rowe reported that to date the Committee had been unable to get a power mower, and it was doubtful if there is one to be had.

A committee from Crystal Lake Gospel Park came before the Council and requested that the City furnish them with water. They stated that in order for them to get a priority for pipes etc. to put in their water system that the War Production Board requested a letter from the City of Milwaukie stating the City's willingness to furnish the water. Mrs Farrington was authorized to write the letter.

The Treasurer's report was read and ordered filed.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Sperr that Officer Shockley be paid \$100.00 per month, to be retroactive to April 1, Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by Newman that Mrs. Farrington be granted her vacation the first two weeks in June. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Newman and seconded by Sperr that the City sell to Mr. Phillips a Bates Numbering Machine at a price set by Mr. DeVee. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Newman that the following bills be allowed and that the Recorder be directed to issue warrants for the payment of same.
