605th MEETING

The six hundred fifth regular meeting of the Council was held on the twenty-second day of May, 1944

The minutes of the six hundred fourth regular meeting of the Council, held on the eighth day of May 1944 were read and approved as read.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by McClure that all operators of coin vending machines in Milwaukie be notified to remove all such machines, except pin-ball machines, by June 1, 1944, that these coin vending machines will not be licensed and if found in places of business after June 1, 1944, they will be confiscated and destroyed. Motion carried and so ordered.

Busses It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Newman that the matter of Buss Franchise be tabled until the first Council meeting in June. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Sperr that the following bills be allowed and that the Recorder be directed to issue warrants for the payment of same.
