

MEETING OF JUNE 26, 1944

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

607th MEETING

The six hundred seventh meeting of the Council was held on the twenty-sixth day of June 1944.

The meeting was called to order by president of the Council Sperr.

Present. Councilmen Sperr, Bevington and McClure, Treasurer Farrington, Water Superintendant Counsell and Recorder Martin.
Absent: Mayor Roberts, Councilmen Newman and Rowe, and Fire Chief Lewellyn.

The minutes of the six hundred sixth regular meeting of the Council, held on the nineteenth day of June 1944, were read and corrected.

Ordinance Number 447, AN ORDINANCE providing a tax levy on all taxable property within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, for city purposes for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1944 and ending June 30, 1945, was taken up and read for the first time. Ordinance Number 447 was read the second and third times by title only with the consent of the Council and put on its passage with the following results being had, Ayes: Bevington, McClure and Sperr. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 447 passed the Council and was so declared.

It was moved by McClure and seconded by Bevington that the insurance on the City Hall and contents be renewed with New York Underwriters Insurance Co. (C.F. Richardson, agent). Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by McClure and seconded by Bevington that a warrant be drawn on the General Fund for \$418.75 for a power lawn mower, the check to be held until the delivery of the mower. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by McClure and seconded by Bevington that a warrant for \$400.00 be drawn on the General Fund, in payment of interior painting to be done in the City Hall, the check to be held until the painting is finished. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by McClure and seconded by Bevington that a warrant be drawn on the Street Fund to the Portland Road and Driveway Co. for \$2,058.45 for work done on City Streets. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by McClure and seconded by Bevington that the following bills be allowed and that the Recorder be directed to issue warrants for the payment of same.
