

MEETING OF JULY 10, 1944

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

608th MEETING

The six hundred eighth regular meeting of the Council was held on the tenth day of July 1944.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Roberts

Present: Mayor Roberts, Councilmen Newman, Bevington, Sperr and Rowe. Water Superintendant Counsell, Officer Butler, Fire Chief Lewellyn and Recorder Martin. Absent: Councilman McClure and Treasurer Walcott.

The minutes of the six hundred seventh regular meeting of the Council, held on the twenty-sixth day of June 1944, were read and approved as read.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by Newman that the Recorder institute necessary proceedings to vacate 29th street between Washington street and Madison street Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by Newman that the Recorder institute necessary proceedings to vacate a triangle of land adjacent to Block 16, Quincy Addition. This triangle having been platted as a part of 34th street, Motion carried and so ordered

Mr. Harry Newman presented plans for remodeling the front part of his building on Block 1, Lewelling Park Addition, and asked for a building permit It was moved by Sperr and seconded by Rowe that the permit be granted. Motion carried and so ordered

Mr Ivar Tolstead came before the Council and suggested that the City license the business houses where coin vending machines are operated, instead of licensing the machines. The Council advised Mr Tolstead that in order to comply with Ordinance Number 441, the license must be issued for the machine.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Sperr that Leo Butler be employed as police officer at \$200.00 per month salary and an allowance not to exceed \$50.00 per month for car operation expense and gasoline. Motion carried and so ordered.

Ordinance Number 448, AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance Number 441 by increasing the number of legal coin vending machines from twelve to eighteen, was taken up and read for the first time. Ordinance Number 448 was read the second and third times by title only with the consent of the Council and put on its passage with the following results being had. Ayes: Bevington, Sperr and Rowe. Nays: none. Ordinance Number 448 was passed by the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.

It was moved by Sperr and seconded by Bevington that the Recorder notify residents in the north-east part of the City as to what their correct house number is and request that they place the correct numbers on their houses. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Sperr that the Treasurer's-Auditor's monthly report be accepted as presented. Motion carried and so ordered.

The Fire Chief's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Sperr that the Recorder write a letter to First ~~National~~ Bank of Milwaukie, notifying them of the change of the Treasurer's name and requesting them to honor the new signature of Mrs. Walcott. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Sperr that Mrs. Newman be authorized to purchasr venitian blinds for the Council chamber windows. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Rowe and seconded by Sperr that the following bills be allowed and that the Recorder be directed to issue warrants for the payment of same.
