

MEETING OF AUGUST 24, 1943.

COUNCIL CHAMBERS.

587th MEETING

The five hundred eighty-seventh regular meeting of the Council was held on the twenty-fourth day of August 1943.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Roberts.

Present: Mayor Roberts, Councilmen Bevington, McClure, and Sperr. Attorney Adams, Treasurer Farrington, Fire Chief Fenton, Officer Rigdon and Recorder Martin. Absent: Councilmen Newman and Rowe, and Water Superintendant Counsell.

The minutes of the five hundred eighty-sixth regular meeting of the Council held on the ninth day of August 1943, were read and approved as read.

Ordinance Number 441, AN ORDINANCE to regulate and license certain mechanical amusement devices commonly known and referred to as "slot or coin machines" under Chapter 369, Laws 1935, State of Oregon, and to repeal Ordinance Number 378, was taken up the first time and read, Ordinance Number 441 was read the second, and third times by

title only with the consent of the Council and put on its passage with the following results being had. Ayes: Bevington and McClure, Nays: Sperr. Ordinance Number 441 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.

It was moved by Sperr and seconded by McClure that the City ask \$125.00 for Lot 23 Block 8 Quincy Addition. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. Sperr reported that he expected to obtain the services of Portland Road and Driveway Co. to work on some of the City streets very soon. It was agreed that Mr. Sperr should get help wherever he could to have traffic paint applied to streets wherever it was necessary

It was moved by Sperr and seconded by Bevington that the following bills be allowed and that the Recorder be directed to issue warrants for the payment of same.
