

MEETING OF OCTOBER 25, 1943

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

591st MEETING

The five hundred ninety-first regular meeting of the Council was held on the twenty-fifth day of October 1943.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Roberts.

Present: Mayor Roberts, Councilmen Bevington, McClure, Sperr and Rowe, Fire Chief Fenton, Officer Rigdon and Recorder Martin.  
Absent: Councilman Newman, Treasurer Farrington and Water Superintendent Counsell.

The minutes of the five hundred nintieth regular meeting of the Council held on the eleventh day of October were read and corrected.

Ordinance Number 442, AN ORDINANCE establishing the finished surface grades of Washington Street between the west property line of Main street and the east property line of Front street, was taken up and read for the first time. Ordinance number 442 was read the second and third times by title only, with the consent of the Council, and put on its passage with the following results being had, Ayes: Bevington, McClure, Sperr and Rowe. Nays: None. Ordinance Number 442 passed the Council and was so declared by the Mayor.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by McClure that the Mayor be authorized to purchase five gallons of paint to be used on the outside woodwork of the City Hall. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by McClure that the Bench Marks throughout the Town be stamped with their true elevations. Motion carried and so ordered.

A group of members of the Northern Clackamas County Fire Protection Committee, with Mr. J.W. Jones, chairman, as speaker, came before the Council and explained their plans for creating and maintaining a Fire District, for Fire Protection. The district would take in that territory surrounding Milwaukie, in Clackamas County, which is not now under fire protection. The Committee made inquiry as to the ability of Milwaukie to house another piece of Fire fighting equipment. Mr. Sperr stated that Milwaukie had room for another piece of equipment and room for more men.

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It was moved by McClure and seconded by Bevington that the City cooperate with the Northern Clackamas County Fire Protection Committee in the most feasible manner. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Sperr and seconded by Rowe that the City pay Mr. Wm. Adams \$150.00 for past services rendered. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by Rowe that the Recorder's salary be \$125.00 per month to be retroactive to July 1, 1943. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by Sperr that the Recorder check on the price paid by the City for a small oil stove for the Mayor's office and that she be authorized to sell same. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by Sperr that the following bills be allowed and that the Recorder be directed to issue warrants for the payment of same.
