

MEETING OF NOVEMBER 27, 1944

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

617th MEETING

The six hundred seventeenth regular meeting of the Council was held on the twenty-seventh day of November 1944.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Roberts.

Present: Mayor Roberts; Councilmen Newman, Bevington, McClure and Sperr; Water Superintendant Counsell, Officer Butoer and Recorder Martin. Absent: Councilman Rowe, Treasurer Walcott and Fire Chief Lewellyn.

The minutes of the six hundred sixteenth regular meeting of the Council, held on the thirteenth day of November, 1944 were read and corrected.

It was moved by McClure and seconded by Sperr that Post Office Inspector J.E.Fitzgerald be invited to meet with the City Council and the Planning Commission for the purpose of discussing plans for a new Post Office in Milwaukie. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by McClure and seconded by Bevington that Mrs. Newman be authorized to contract with the Federal Government for their use of the City Hall basement for handling surplus Christmas mail. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by Sperr that the Evangelical Church be granted a permit to build a private garage on Lot 7 Block 38 Milwaukie. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Sperr and seconded by Bevington that Ivar and Edith Tolstead be granted recommendation for their renewal application for 1945 retail beer Class " B" license. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by Sperr that the insurance on the Seagraves Fire Truck be renewed with Albert Combs. Motion carried and so ordered.

Attorney Adams read Ordinance Number 455, An Ordinance providing that no buildings may be constructed in Milwaukie without a permit being first obtained from the City Council, providing a penalty, and repealing Ordinance Number 349. It was moved by Bevington and seconded by McClure that Ordinance Number 455 be posted. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by Newman that the insurance on furniture and fixtures in the City Hall be renewed with Mr. A.F.Huffman. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Sperr and seconded by Bevington that the burglary insurance be renewed with C.F.Richardson. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by McClure and seconded by Bevington that the stand-by fire truck be insured for property damage and bodily injury with Mr. Albert Combs. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Bevington and seconded by McClure that Mr. Sperr be authorized to sell the City's road grader. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Newman and seconded by McClure that, in order to protect the City's lien against Lot 25 Block 7 Quincy Addition, the City redeem the same from the County. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. C.W.Hall, 4033 Howie street, came before the Council and requested that he be permitted to have Bull Run water piped to his residence for household use. Mr. Hall was advised to contact Mr. George Flagg of the Public Utilities Commission and learn as to

It was moved by Newman and seconded by McClure that the following bills be allowed and that the Recorder be directed to issue warrants for the payment of same.
