

COUNCIL CHAMBER'S FEBRUARY 27, 1939

The four hundred eighty-third regular meeting of the Council was held on the 27th day of February, 1939.

The meeting was called to order by President of the Council Roberts.

Present: Councilmen Gillem, Mourer Roberts and Rudder; Water Superintendent Bevington, Marshal Stanley, Fire Chief Lewellyn and Recorder Adams.

It was moved by Rudder and seconded by Mourer that the City waive one-half of the interest due on the sewer assessment relative to Lot 7, Block 1, Brownell Acres providing the assessment is paid in full at once. Motion carried and so ordered.

The question of Officer Stanley's salary was taken up. It was moved by Mourer and seconded by Rudder that E. A. Stanley be employed for the year 1939 as Marshal and Police Officer on the same basis as his original employment.

Fire Chief Lewellyn brought up the question of window slides for the Firemen's sleeping quarters. It was moved by Gillem and seconded by Mourer that window shades be purchased for the Firemen's sleeping quarters. Motion carried and so ordered.

Upon motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
