

COUNCIL CHAMBER'S MARCH 13, 1939

The four hundred eighty-fourth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 13th day of March 1939.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Burdick.

Present: Mayor Burdick, Councilmen Gillem, Mourer, Roberts and Rudder, Water Superintendent Bevington, Fire Chief Lewellyn, Marshal Stanley and Recorder Adams.

The minutes of the four hundred eighty-second and four hundred eighty-third regular meetings of the Council held respectively on the 13th and 27th days of February, 1939 were each read and were each approved as read.

The Treasurer's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

The Fire Chief's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

The Marshals monthly report was read and ordered filed.

W. Fassett appeared before the Council in behalf of a committee from the Milwaukie Business Men's Club and requested the passage of an ordinance licensing businesses, trades and occupations. Mr. Fassett was asked to bring a definite proposal.

It was moved by Roberts and seconded by Gillem that the Street Commissioner have the City Hall grounds plowed. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mayor Burdick reported that the Bill before the legislature to provide that a portion of the State gasoline tax money go to the Cities failed to pass.

It was moved by Rudder and seconded by Roberts that Dan Faulder be employed as City Park Caretaker for six months commencing March 15th at a salary of \$25.00 per month. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Mourer and seconded by Roberts that the following bills be approved and that the Recorder issue warrants covering same.
